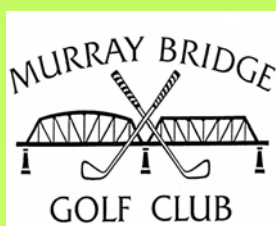

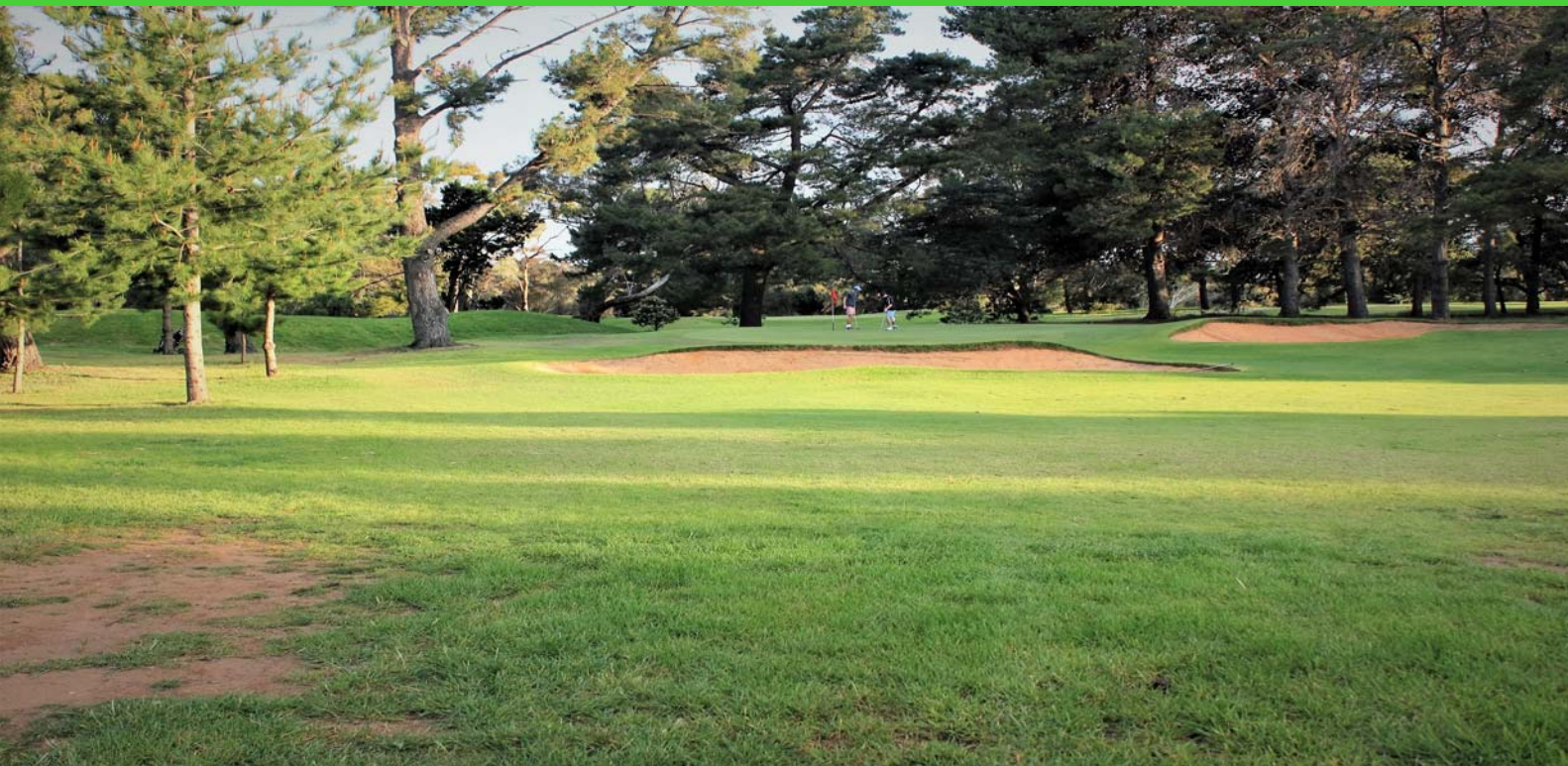

TOURNAMENT QUALIFICATIONS

In order to participate in an Australian Golfing Fellowship of Rotarians Tournament, an entrant shall be a member of an Australian Rotary Club, a financial member of an affiliated Golf Club, have a certified Australian Course Rating Handicap or equivalent and reside in Australia. Rotarians who reside outside Australia may compete in the tournament as a "Rotarian Guest" if they comply with the above requirements but are not eligible for the Sir Clem Renouf, Royce Abbey, Senior Rotarian or Victorian trophy. The rules are those of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, supplemented each day by the local rules of the course and the rules of the AGFR.

Rotarian Golfer Handicap 0—15

Division 2: (Men & Women)

Rotarian Golfer Handicap 16-23

Division Golfer Handicap 24—36 (Men)

and 24—45 (Women)

One Division for Guests:

Men 0—36, Women 0—45

A **Guest** shall be a male or female who is either the spouse or partner of a participating Rotarian or a Rotarian Guest who accompanies the Rotarian to the tournament.

The minimum number of players in each division shall be 12.

Should there be less than 12 entries in a division then the committee may elect to include all competitors in one division.

All players are required to provide proof of handicap to the registration desk at the tournament.

Team events—Teams will be selected as follows:

All entrants will be listed in order of receipt, the midpoint of handicaps determined and participants paired, one from the upper half and one from the lower half.

Pairings will be from different States, different Districts, or different Rotary Clubs, in that order.

All entrants will be drawn in the teams events.

If there are an odd number of entries, the last entrant will be paired with the first entrant received from the other half of the draw and from a different State.
